COMMONWEALTH GAMES

Monique Gladding & Nick Robinson-Baker competed in the 2010 Commonwealth Games in India in October. Nick produced a strong performance in both the 1 metre and 3 metre springboard finals. In the 1 metre he comfortably qualified for the final and was in the mix for a medal until missing his last dive to finish in 6th place. He went one place better in the 3m event, finishing just 21 points away from a medal in 5th. Monique Gladding qualified for the 10metre platform final in 4th place, just 11 points behind the leader. Diving consistently, she achieved a similar total score in the final but dropped 2 places to finish 6th, only 20 points away from a medal.
